

Canada 150 Eh! Mystery KAL – supply list



Needles:

2.75mm US #2, 16 inch circs and dpns;
3.25mm US#3 16inch circs and dpns;
markers and the regular notions.

Yarn:

Fingering – 50 – 75 grs main, 50grs,
contrast, 50gr contrast. Simplest version
of project requires 2 colours only.

Now it is time to pick colours for our
Canada 150 Eh! Project. Now, does
Canada mean different colours for
different people as well? I think that
colours are subjective to surroundings
and interests.

I personally think that my Canadian
colours are the Greens, Blues and Greys
of the Wet West Coast – not that I chose
to use them in my samples. If you are
from the Prairies your Canadian colours
might be Blue, Gold and Grey/Greens, not
that you need to pick those three colours
if you are from the Prairies.

And then there are the Sports Fans – I used sport team influences for some of my possible colour selections.
