

# *Ode to ... Stranding Class*

**How Much?** \$40.00

**Where:** Heritage Mews, upstairs in the workroom if it rains or out in the Courtyard if it is Sunny!

**What:** Learn how to knit and carry a yarn when not knitting with it. The easy repetitive pattern is never carried over more than 3 sts, making the pattern easy to work and memorize.

**Supplies:** 65 to 95 gms of sport weight or light dk yarns, sample used Cascade 220 Superwash Sport 25 to 40 gms main colour (green), 15 to 20 gms each of 2 colours, the mid tone (soft green) and light tone (yellow) and 10 to 15 gms of the accent colour (pink); 3.5mm US #4 16 inch circ needle for ribbing; 3.75mm US #5 16 inch circ needle and dpn's for body; marker and the regular notions. **Note** – if you haven't worked a center double decrease – used in the crown shaping please bring some dpn's and waste yarn on which to learn the decrease.

**Pattern will be provided.**

**Homework:** Come with the ribbing knit: the class is all about the colour work stranding.

Cast-on 96 (108, 120, 132) sts with 3.5mm needle and main colour. Being careful not to twist the sts pm and join into a round.

Work 12 (14, 14, 16) rounds 2 x 2 ribbing

Next round – increase round – K8 (9, 10, 11), M1 – repeat 12 times around hat – 108 (120, 132, 144) sts.

**Break:** There will be a short break at about 2:00 pm.
