Stash Busting 101!

Look Ma! No Knitting!

Got yarn, don't want to knit, crochet or weave with it, why not try yarn wrapping?! Darlene is always looking for new and creative ways to deal with stash yarns! And this one can be used to create yarn bowls, stash bowls, baskets and containers of any size.

This yarn bowl is created by wrapping yarn around a firm rope center. A strong tapestry needle is used to help with the wrapping.

**Cost:** \$55.00

There is an extra materials cost, \$15.00, payable to Darlene in the first class for the rope center of the project.

**Materials:** 250 – 300 yds chunky yarn. Sample used Marble Chunky; a strong, heavy tapestry needle, and scissors.

1<sup>st</sup> week. Learn the basics of the wrapping and coiling technique

2<sup>nd</sup> week. Take the coiling from the flat bottom to working up the sides

3<sup>rd</sup> week. Finishing the piece
